

Scholarships available to the graduating class of 2025 through the Elcho School Scholarship Fund

- All applicants must be graduating seniors.
- All applicants must be enrolled in an accredited college or technical school as a full-time student.
(Taking 12 or more credits)
- All scholarships require proof of community service.
- See each scholarship for individual scholarship requirements.

KTC Memorial Fund Scholarship \$1500

- * "C" average (2.0 GPA) or above
- * Has demonstrated good school and community citizenship.

Cieslak Family Scholarship (3) \$1000

- * Must have been on the Honor Roll during high school career

Elwyn Remington Foundation Scholarship (5) \$1000 (per year)

- * Graduating senior must have at least 3.0 GPA, service to their community and school, and a financial need.
- * \$1000 per year, maximum of 4 years
- * Student must furnish proof that they completed their 1st semester in good academic standing with at least 3.0 GPA. Payment will then be awarded.
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester

C.A.R. Scholarship \$1000

- * "C" average (2.0 GPA) or above
- * Given to a student with a greater financial need

Post Lake Improvement Association (PLIA) Scholarship \$1000

- * Given to a student with plans to attend a 2-year technical school, preferably NTC or Nicolet
- * "C" average (2.0 GPA) or above
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester

Pelican Lake Firemen Award (2) \$750

- * The scholarship shall be awarded in priority of the fields listed below:
 1. Fire Fighting or Fire Science
 2. Emergency Medical Services
 3. Nursing
 4. Natural Resources or Wildland Fire Fighting
 5. Other forms of public service
- After considering the above, a continuing education scholarship may be considered for the top three fields
- * A "C" average (2.0 GPA) for all four years of high school is required

Visser Family Community Service Award \$500

- * "C" average (2.0 GPA) or above
- * Must include a statement describing community involvement

Elcho Fire Department Scholarship \$500

- * Going into one of the following fields of study:
 1. Medical
 2. Police Science
 3. Firefighting
- * "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above

Excellence Award \$500

- * Going to a 4-year university
- * Must be in the top third of his/her class
- * Has volunteered in the community

Mary Ann McCarthy Scholarship \$500

- * Top 10 in class
- * Played two high school sports for at least three years
- * Short essay based on the senior's experience with an older person and how that experience made a difference in the senior's life.

Hyland Lakes Lions Scholarship \$500

- * "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above
- * Priority given to a student entering a "Public Service" field of study.
- * Given to a student with a greater financial need.

Keith and Nancy Skidmore Family Scholarship \$500

- * Male or Female student that chooses any Armed Forces Branch either as enlisted or via ROTC in college. Must provide proof of enrollment and be full time college student or provide completion of boot camp to receive funds.
- * Male or Female student that chooses a trade school. Must provide proof of enrollment and be full time student.
- * Male or Female student that enrolls and is accepted into an Apprenticeship Program. Must provide proof of acceptance and enrollment.

David G. Stefan Scholarship Fund \$500

- * Priority given based on need
- * School participation (athletics, music, drama, academic)
- * Community participation

Clifford Westphal-Danielski Scholarship \$500

- * Must attend a face-to-face/in-person continuing education program
- * "C+" average (2.5 GPA) or above
- * Given to student with greater financial need
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester. Must provide proof of 2.5 GPA from 1st semester.

John (Gary) Alfred Peterson-Danielski Scholarship \$500

- * Must attend a face-to-face/in-person continuing education program
- * "C+" average (2.5 GPA) or above
- * Given to student with greater financial need
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester. Must provide proof of 2.5 GPA from 1st semester.

American Legion Scholarship (2) \$500

- * Given to a student with a greater financial need
- * "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above

Challenge Award \$400

- * Include an essay on the biggest challenge that you have had and how you have had to overcome it. What have you learned from this? *500 word minimum

GFWC Antigo Junior Woman's Club Scholarship \$400

- * "C" average (2.0 GPA) or above
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester

Elcho PTO Scholarship \$250

- * "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above
- * Participated in at least one extra-curricular during senior year

Ladies of Summit Lake Scholarship \$250

- * Graduate in good standing
- * Must be attending a 2+ year accredited post high school program
- * Payment will be awarded 2nd semester

Elcho Explorers 4H Scholarship \$250

- * Given to a student with a greater financial need
- * "B" average (3.0 GPA) or above

Elcho Trap Club Scholarship (2) \$250

- * Graduate in good standing
- * Priority given to a trap club student
